



RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE DELLOW REGISTER -NOVEMBER 2004

NAME

The Register shall be called "DELLOW REGISTER" (hereafter referred to as the Register)

OBJECTS

- (a) To provide an organisation to keep the breed together world wide.
- (b) To obtain as much information as possible about Dellows.
- (c) To provide members with information advice and assistance on matters connected with Dellows.
- (d) To encourage the running and authentic restoration of Dellow.
- (e) To encourage the sale of Dellow to prospective enthusiasts.
- (f) To run motor sport events in accordance with the rules of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association

ORGANISATION

- (a) Overall control of the Register, its property and finance will be by the committee consisting of 8 members as elected at each AGM.
- (b) A meeting of members will be held once a year. This shall be known as the Annual General Meeting (AGM) where all Register activities and organisation will be reviewed and discussed.
- (c) In the event of a resignation, inability to continue in office for any reason or a failure to elect an officer/committee member at the agm, a majority of the other elected members of the committee may appoint a member to serve in the respective office until the next AGM.

MEMBERSHIP

Shall be open to all persons owning Dellow motor cars. Associate membership shall be open to those persons not owning a Dellow but having an interest in Dellow motor cars. Membership and Associate Membership shall be subject to accepting the rules and regulations of the Register. Membership of the Register shall continue only for the period covered by the current subscription.

SUBSCRIPTION

The subscription to be paid on the first day of January. All monies shall be payable to "Dellow Register". The amount of subscriptions shall be as determined from time to time by the committee.

NON-PAYMENT

Any member of the Register who has not paid the subscription within one clear calendar month of the date on which it becomes due shall be notified. One calendar month thereafter any member who has still failed to pay his subscription will forfeit all membership rights.

RESIGNATION

Any members wishing to resign his membership shall give notice in writing of such a desire to the Area Secretary on or before the date on which the subscription would have become due for renewal, otherwise he shall be liable to pay his subscription for the ensuing year. Also any member ceasing voluntarily or otherwise to be a member of the Register shall thereafter cease to have any claim upon the property of the Register or to enjoy any of the privileges of membership, but he shall remain liable for the payments of any debts due to the Register from him.

CONDUCT

Members shall not conduct themselves in any manner so as to bring the name of the Register into disrepute. Any complaint regarding the conduct of a member shall be referred to the committee which shall take such action as it considers necessary.

EXPULSION OF MEMBERS

It shall be the duty of the committee if at any time they shall be in the opinion that the interests of the Register so require by letter to invite any member to withdraw from the Register, within a time specified in such letter and in default of withdrawal to submit the question of his expulsion to a meeting of the committee to be held within six weeks after the date of such letter. Members of the committee shall be given seven days notice that a meeting of the committee is to discuss the question of a withdrawal or expulsion. The members whose expulsion is under consideration shall be given at least seven day's notice of such a meeting, and shall be allowed to offer verbally or in writing an explanation of his conduct. If two thirds of the committee members present shall then vote for his expulsion he shall thereupon cease to be a member of the Register.

OBSERVANCE AND INTERPRETATION OF THE RULES

Every member binds himself to abide by the rules of the Register as set out in these Rules and Regulations and also to accept as final and binding the decision of the committee in all cases of dispute or disagreement as to the interpretation of these Rules and Regulations.

USE OF REGISTER NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of the Register shall not be given by a member as his address for any trade, advertising or business purpose, or in connection with any legal proceedings. The Register, however, will approve the use of the name "Dellow Register" by members wishing only to enter teams in motoring events.

EVENTS

All motor competitions promoted by the Register shall be held under the General Competition Rules of the Royal Automobile Club, Motor Sports Association and in accordance with any other requirements of the MSA.

Any member convicted of an offence arising out of his being in charge of a motor vehicle in any Register event or on Register business shall thereupon be liable to expulsion from the Register under rule 9.

DISSOLUTION

The Register may be dissolved by a Special General Meeting convened by direction of the committee, or by the requisition of the majority of the members. If a resolution of dissolution be duly passed the committee shall forthwith liquidate the affairs of the Register and if there be surplus assets on realisation these may be disposed of at the discretion of the committee. Should these assets of the Register be insufficient to meet any debts the Members of the Register shall be jointly and severally liable for payment of such debts.
